# **K&D SITE PARKING**

### Meeting: Parks and Recreation Committee

### **Question:**

The UTAS-owned K&D site appears to have provided use almost exclusively for basketball facilities. It appears that there is leasing being undertaken of car parks for \$200 per car park by the basketball organisation and the university. Has the Council any influence on the university's use of this facility in response to an overall plan for access by other sports codes to the former K&D site?

## **Response:**

The former K&D site in freehold title was purchased by the University of Tasmania for future university purposes.

The Council has no authority over the temporary use of the site or the management of the infrastructure in the meantime. The current use as basketball courts and daily parking are matters for the University to determine but are not inappropriate uses of the site at that location.
