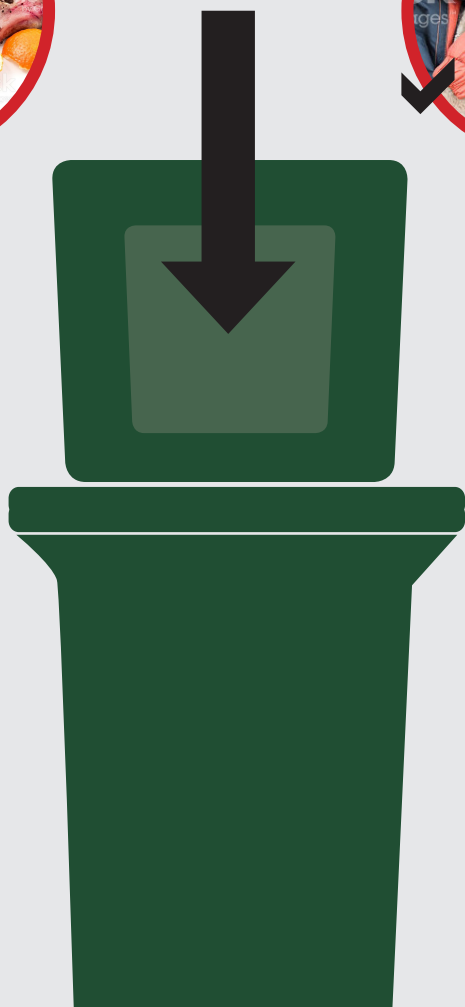
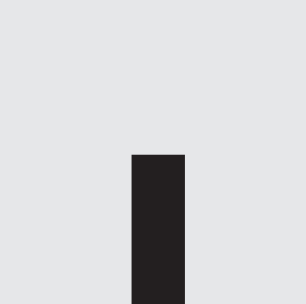


# GENERAL WASTE

## What goes in?

- ✓ Plastic bags
- ✓ Nappies
- ✓ Broken crockery & glassware
- ✓ Foam packaging, cups & food trays
- ✓ Plastic packaging
- ✓ Animal droppings
- ✓ Food waste
- ✓ Rags & textiles

## What doesn't go in?

- ✗ Recyclables including cardboard, paper, cans, tins, plastic containers & bottles.
- ✗ Green/garden waste – this goes in your green waste bin
- ✗ Hazardous substances including chemicals, poison & paint\*
- ✗ Batteries\*
- ✗ Florescent light globes & tubes\*
- ✗ Gas cylinders\*
- ✗ Re-usable items such as household items and clothes\*
