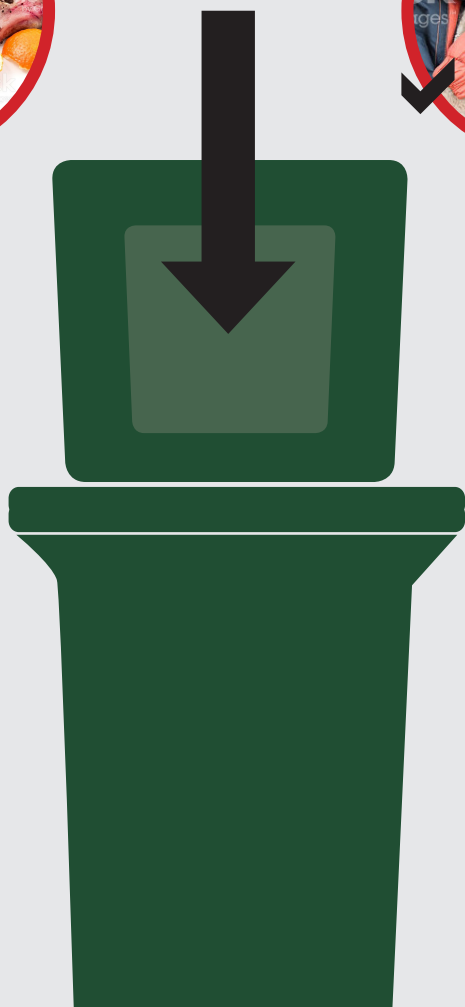


GENERAL WASTE



The City of Hobart aims to achieve zero waste to landfill by 2030. That means working together to recycle as much as we can and reduce waste.

What goes in?

- ✓ Plastic bags
- ✓ Nappies
- ✓ Broken crockery & glassware
- ✓ Foam packaging, cups & food trays
- ✓ Plastic packaging
- ✓ Animal droppings
- ✓ Rags & textiles

What doesn't go in?

- ✗ Recyclables including cardboard, paper, cans, tins, plastic containers & bottles.
- ✗ Green/garden waste – this goes in your FOGO bin
- ✗ Food waste – this goes in your FOGO bin
- ✗ Hazardous substances including chemicals, poison & paint*
- ✗ Batteries*
- ✗ Florescent light globes & tubes*
- ✗ Gas cylinders*
- ✗ Re-usable items such as household items and clothes*
